**TOWN OF BARGERSVILLE, INDIANA  
TOWN COUNCIL RESOLUTION NO.**

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF CONGRESSMAN SHREVE'S SUBMISSION OF THE CR 144 SAFETY AND RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT FOR FEDERAL FUNDING THROUGH THE COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Town of Bargersville has identified County Road 144 (CR 144) as a critical transportation corridor that connects Interstate 69 (I-69) and Interstate 65 (I-65) south of Indianapolis, serving as a key economic and logistical link for the region and the State of Indiana; and

WHEREAS, CR 144 has been determined by the Bargersville Town Council to be a dangerous and increasingly hazardous roadway, with safety concerns exacerbated by increased vehicular traffic, economic expansion, and population growth; and

WHEREAS, the current and anticipated growth of the Town of Bargersville, projected at a rate of 10–18% over the next five years, necessitates substantial infrastructure investment to maintain safety, efficiency, and accommodate future traffic volumes; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the CR 144 Safety and Reconstruction Project, which focuses on the CR 144/CR 625 intersection, includes the purchase of right-of-way and construction of a modern roundabout to significantly improve safety and relieve congestion; and

WHEREAS, the intersection in its current condition is a two-way stop-controlled intersection with a free-flow CR 144, suffering from a severely skewed layout, obstructed sight lines due to natural landscape features, and an overall poor Level of Service (LOS), forecasted to reach LOS F by or before the year 2050; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the complete redesign and reconstruction of CR 144 is estimated at \$40 million, with Phase 1 estimated at \$4.9 million; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Bargersville has submitted this project to Congressman Shreve's Community Project Funding initiative, and the Council expresses its sincere appreciation for Congressman Shreve's support and selection of the project for consideration in the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS, the reconstruction of CR 144 is essential for advancing economic development, improving public safety, supporting job creation, and enhancing the quality of life for residents of Bargersville and all Hoosiers.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BARGERSVILLE, INDIANA, THAT:**

1. The Town Council formally supports Congressman Shreve's submission of the CR 144 Safety and Reconstruction Project for Community Project Funding.
2. The Council affirms the critical need for federal support to implement this project in a timely and effective manner.
3. The Town of Bargersville commits to working collaboratively with federal, state, and local partners to ensure the successful delivery of this infrastructure investment.
4. A copy of this resolution shall be transmitted to Congressman Shreve and other relevant federal and state offices as a statement of the Town's full support and intent.
